## IAC Releases 2012 Standards for Carotid Stenting Accreditation

PARTICIPATING FACILITIES WILL BENEFIT FROM ENHANCED CLARITY, CONSISTENCY

NOVEMBER 15, 2012 | The Intersocietal Accreditation Commission (IAC) is pleased to announce the official release of the 2012 IAC Standards for Carotid Stenting Accreditation. In continuing our efforts to further evolve the accreditation process, these newly formatted Standards provide enhanced clarity and consistency for applicant facilities.

Standards are the minimum requirements to which an accredited facility is held accountable. The majority of the changes made to the Standards improve upon the organization and structure of the Standards as a whole. Minor revisions made to the Standards from the previous version are highlighted in yellow. *Standards* that are highlighted become effective on November 15, 2012. Facilities applying for accreditation after November 15, 2012 must comply with these new *Standards*.
