

Vein Center Procedure Complications

Sclerotherapy:

- Allergic reactions
- Deep vein thrombosis
- Infection
- Ischemic stroke/TIA
- Skin necrosis (tissue necrosis)
- Visual disturbances
- Other

Ambulatory Phlebectomy:

- Allergic reactions
- Deep vein thrombosis
- Hematoma
- Post-operative bleeding
- Seroma
- Skin slough/blistering
- Wound infection
- Other

EVLT/RFA:

- Allergic reactions (including skin reactions from glue)
- Endovenous Heat Induced Thrombus
- Endovenous Glue Induced Thrombus
- Superficial thrombophlebitis
- Equipment failure
- Failure of treated vessels to close
- Failure to perform the intended procedure
- Hematoma
- Hypesthesia/nerve injury
- Infection
- Pulmonary embolism
- Retained venous access device, wire, catheter or fiber Skin necrosis
- Injury of skin – skin burn 2nd, 3rd, and brownish discoloration
- Skin ulcers
- Other
